



ENC Overnight Program Guidelines:

- Adult supervision required when children are present.
- Camp stoves can be used in the picnic area behind the building only.
- Campfires must be in the campfire circle only. No individual campfires.
- Smoking is prohibited.
- Please clean your area before you leave.
- Please leave your personal game systems, portable TVs, plastic bags, disposable plastic water bottles, pets and alcohol at home.
- Amenities include restrooms and picnic tables. No showers are available.
- Be sure to bring ample food, as well as a propane stove, if you plan to use one.
